Rules

1. The Allalin Races are held in the region between Mittelallalin (3550m) and Saas-Fee (1800) and are considered the highest glacier runs in the world.
2. Only the organizing committee of the Allalin Races decides on possible changes to the present regulations.
3. The course is identical to the existing slopes and no special preparation will be made.
4. All gates on the race course must be crossed.
5. On the glacier, the edge of the piste will be marked with barrier material, flags and the like in places that are not clearly visible (official route). It is only allowed to ski within the marked track. The organizer of the Allalin Races expressly declines any responsibility for accidents of any kind outside the marked track. In case of leaving the official track, the racer will be disqualified.
6. The participants undertake to adapt their speed to the conditions and to ski on sight. In all other aspects the general FIS rules applies, in particular FIS rule no. 2 (control of speed and driving style). The instructions of the marshals with the flags must be strictly followed.
7. The race organizers alone reserve the right to shorten, postpone, cancel or abandon races for safety reasons such as visibility, lack of snow, etc. For races not held, participants will be refunded 50% of the entry fee, exclusively during the race days at the race office. A refund (also 50%) due to illness or accident will only be made against a medical certificate.
8. The participant must respect the starting time. The start number must be worn visibly during the entire race.
9. Training runs on the piste are forbidden for safety reasons. Information regarding training opportunities will be posted in the race office.
10. The helmet obligation is valid for all participants and for all races.
11. Racing suits are forbidden for the FUN races (amateur teams). Closing time of the race (finish) is set to one hour after the effective last start time. The times will be measured, but only the costumes will be awarded.
12. Each participant is obliged to insure himself/herself against accidents. The organizing committee expressly declines any liability in case of accidents. No daily insurance can be taken out through the organizer.

13. The Allalin races (alpine and snowboard) will be held in the following categories:

She + He -downhill	Cat. A Women and men from the age of 16 onwards
Team/club downhill	Cat. B1 3-5 participants per team from 18 years of age
Team/club downhill FUN	Cat. B2 3-5 participants per team from the age of 16 onwards
Allalin Race (Individual)	Cat. C/F women/men 18-35 years
	Cat. D/G women/men 36 - 49 years
	Cat. E Men 50 - 59 years
	Cat. H Ladies 50 years and older
	Cat. I Men 60 years and older

14. The number of participants in the Allalin races is limited:

She + He -downhill	300 pairs alpine
Team/club downhill	180 teams alpine/30 snowboard
Allalin race singles	1100 alpine/100 snowboard

15. The "Allalin" badge will only be awarded at the individual races women/men:

Gold: All category winners
Silver: +30% of the ranked competitors in each category
Bronze: +60% of the ranked participants of each category

16. Violation of these regulations will result in exclusion from the race.

17. As far as there are no other regulations in these rules, the regulations of the Swiss Competition Rules (SCR) are valid.

18. With the written registration, the participant accepts the regulations and the general provisions in full.
